

Quilter's Bingo

We will be playing Bingo at the July guild meeting using quilt blocks that members make. The blocks will be donated to Community Service after the game.

For each block, you will need:

- 5- 2 ½" squares assorted greens
- 5- 2 ½" squares assorted blues
- 4- 2 ½" squares assorted purples and/or pinks
- 1- 2 ½" square black or mostly black print (for the center square)
- 5- 2 ½" squares assorted red prints
- 5- 2 ½" squares assorted yellow and/or orange fabrics

Choose fabric from the following themes:

- batik
- floral
- geometric
- heart
- leaf/leaves
- metallic
- holiday
- novelty (i.e. a print that doesn't meet other themes on this list)
- paisley
- plaid
- solid/blender/grunge
- stripes
- stars
- 30s/vintage prints

NOTES:

- Each square in any one column should be a different theme - (for example, do not put 2 green paisley prints in the same column)
- Some fabrics may meet more than one of the themes, for example holiday and metallic;- however, when used in the bingo block ***you need to select the one theme that it will represent***

Finishing the block:

- Sew the blocks into columns by color-way and join the columns as shown in the diagram below.
- Stay stitch around the edges of the block.
