NOTE ON THE KIT: The \$15 kit fee includes 2 zippers (I have lots of colors), 2 wood hangers, 2 pulls and the pattern.

- If you want to bring your own zippers and hangers and only want the pattern, its \$5.

2 hangers (2 wood ones are included in your kit)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BEST – the plus size metal hangers. See Amazon link • VERY GOOD – a sturdy wood hanger, or a department store garment hanger • MARGINAL – heavy plastic hanger • DO NOT USE – light weight plastic hanger, velvet covered , or dry cleaner wire hanger 	Amazon.com: Extra Wide Wire Hangers for Plus Size Clothes, 19 Inch Stainless Steel Plus Size Hangers Ideal for XL, XXL Shirts, Coats, Dresses, Etc. CLASS SUPPLIES, RESOURCES & INFORMATION

1 1/2 yard duck cloth OR Canvas -- will make 2 bags	44 inches wide – some other options are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • solid canvas is a great choice. Its 60" wide and it doesn't need to be lined. (photo is canvas) • Any heavy upholstery fabric or heavier fabric will work but if threads are exposed on the back it definitely needs to be lined. LET ME CHECK IT!!! • Plain cotton quilting fabric can be used but it needs lining for added support and strength • Don't use anything knit, stretchy or very thin 	Hobby Lobby has duck cloth in several prints. It does need lining though. They also have canvas in a few colors.
1 1/2 yard cotton for lining	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 44" wide – any quilt cotton you have is good. NOTE that this is the main fabric you will see on the front 	Whatever you pick, this is what shows on the front
1/4 yd of a coordinating fabric	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For zipper tabs and 1/4" binding on label pocket 	Scraps from your stash
2/3 yard clear vinyl will make 3 fronts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 54" wide - either the 12 or 16 gauge • 8 gauge is too thin and the 20 is too thick 	Hobby Lobby has clear vinyl on large rolls

BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES	Sewing machine, thread to match, scissors, pen or marker, seam ripper, pins AND clips, extra sewing machine needles, bobbins, extension cord -- A NON-STICK SEWING FOOT IS VERY HELPFUL
